Recycling Tips

- Recycling containers must be at the curb no later than 6am on collection day
- Missed recycling must be reported by 9am the following day.
- Late set outs are not considered missed pickups

SINGLE-STREAM **all-in-one** RECYCLING

The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority "all-in-one," single-stream recycling collection program allows cans, bottles, cardboard and all other paper to be mixed together for recycling. All of these items can go into one recycling container.

*Metal: Recycle aluminum and steel (tin) cans, loose metal jar lids, steel bottle caps, clean aluminum foil, pie plates, and trays.

**Glass: Recycle glass jars and bottles with caps and lids removed. Recycle loose metal caps and lids. Jars and bottles must be empty.

Do not recycle plastics coded



IMPORTANT

- All items must be empty, dry, and free of food residue.
- All material must be loose in a container, not in a bag.
- Do not tie cardboard or newspapers.
- Styrofoam is not acceptable in this program.
- No plastic bags or film.
- No shredded paper.
